- The candidate shall show clear signs of continued productivity of highest quality research (e.g., a strong pipeline of working papers and work-in-progress projects) with good chances of publication in the top finance and/or economics journals.
- It would be considered an asset if the candidate's profile included documented expertise at the intersection of digital finance and institutions or sustainable finance and institutions.
- The candidate shall have comprehensive teaching experience at the undergraduate as well as the graduate level, in any area of finance.
- Additional requirements include either a PhD in Finance or Economics.
- The University of Luxembourg is set in a multilingual context. The person hired on this position must be proficient in English and in one of the two official languages of Luxembourg: French or German. The University encourages its staff to learn the other official language and provides access to language courses to this end.
