Position requirements

We are looking for applicants specialized in Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) and Sustainable Development in terms of both research and teaching. Applicants shall hold a Ph.D. and have an established (for Full and Associate levels) or promising (for Assistant level) record of research publications in peer-reviewed international journals. In line with our school's strategic axes, we particularly welcome candidates whose research areas include strategic CSR, political CSR, stakeholders, grand challenges, complex systems, energy transition and eco-industrial design, business ethics, sustainability-oriented and responsible innovation, responsible leadership, sustainable business models, sustainable finance, ESG ratings and CSR disclosure, diversity and inclusion, food sustainability and corruption among others. Evidence of attracting research funding is a plus.

Position overview

The new faculty member will join our Department of Organization Studies & Ethics at Audencia. The department consists of 25 permanent faculty members.
