About the positions

Relying on its strong and continuous growth, NEOMA Business School is seeking to hire **Full-time**, **all ranks permanent/tenured faculty members in** all **areas of finance**, **including** – but not limited to – **big data, machine learning, decentralized finance**, **entrepreneurial finance**, **fintech, asset pricing, corporate finance**. Applications are welcomed to any professorial level – Assistant, Associate, or Full. Please notice that all positions (including the Assistant Professor positions) at NEOMA are permanent, tenured positions.

This is a fantastic time for research-oriented scholars to join NEOMA. Consequently, while we will carefully consider all high-quality applicants, applications from candidates with expertise within one or more of these four Areas are particularly welcomed.

In addition to the resources available through the Areas, we provide individual-level research



support, including – among other things – an individual annual budget for conference travel and other research expenses, assistance in conducting studies in our two experimental behavioral labs, and support in applying for external funding and grants.

The compensation package is consistent with international standards (with the addition of generous bonuses linked to one's publications). We also provide support for administrative procedures related to settlement in France and assistance in finding accommodation, family integration (school registration for children, help with job search for your partner), French training (for you and your partner), and relocation expenses.

- Have a proactive and collegial attitude toward their colleagues, their department, and the school

Additional elements such as a research statement, teaching statement, and any evidence of service to the research, academic, and/or business community can also be included with your application. Positions typically start in late August 2023.
