### The Organisation

Formed by the merger of Dublin Institute of Technology, Institute of Technology Tallaght and Institute of Technology Blanchardstown, the significant scale of TU Dublin serves to emphasise its importance in the higher education landscape in Ireland. With approximately 28,500 students and a dedicated staff of over 3,000, it is the second largest University in Ireland.

### The Role
