Required profile for the PhD position

- A master's degree, preferably in Management Studies or Economics
- Proof of fluency in English
- A passion for research
- Ability to work independently
- An interest in topics on which research is being undertaken by KEDGE's Research Centres

Candidates for the programme are selected on the basis of their CVs, academic references, and interviews with potential supervisors.

Job description

- Approximately 50% of the position's time will be dedicated to the completion of doctoral studies
- Approximately 50% will be dedicated to providing teaching and research support

Conditions of employment

Our PhD positions are fully funded for a period of up to 4 years. Appointed PhD candidates are employees of KEDGE Business School and will receive a salary of approximately €2300 per month gross, including healthcare benefits.

Following the 3-paper model, a PhD thesis at KEDGE consists of three related academic papers submitted to high-quality academic journals. The PhD programme offers extensive training in research methods, and students are encouraged to regularly attend research seminars. PhD students are expected to teach undergraduate and master's courses, normally in English. Training in pedagogy is available. Positions are full-time, for up to four years, starting in **September 2026 or January 2027**.

The submission deadline for applications is **Sunday, 1st February 2026**. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to interviews (possibly via MS Teams) with KEDGE faculty members.
