Tenure Track position in Accounting

The University of Vaasa creates an inspiring environment for meaningful work as part of a thriving and diverse university community. We are now inviting applications for a **Tenure Track position in Accounting, especially in Data Analytics in Business**. The position will be filled either as a fixed-term *Assistant Professor* or *Associate Professor* position within the Tenure track system, or as a permanent *Professor* position. The level is determined by the applicant's merits and career stage.

Job description and requirements

The field of the position is *Accounting, especially data analytics in business*. The research profile of the position is linked to [Auditing and Control in Accounting](#) research group in the [School of Accounting and Finance](#). The task of the selected person is to further strengthen the School's research activities in its focus areas. The research of the position should be oriented to one of the University's strategic focus areas: energy transition and technology, business management, and governance and society. In line with the strategy of the University of Vaasa, the position holder can take part in the actions of the multidisciplinary

research platforms of the University.

Applicants are required to have a relevant doctoral degree as well as excellent academic credentials, evidence of potential to produce outstanding research, and evidence of high-quality teaching or potential to do so. The tenure track position is research-oriented, but also includes teaching, thesis supervision, applying external funding for research projects, and university administrative duties. The teaching and supervision duties are focused on the Bachelor's Programme in Accounting and Finance and Master's Programme in Accounting and Auditing. In addition, the applicant will participate in supervision and teaching under the University's doctoral program.

In the position of Professor, practical non-academic experience in the field is not required but can be considered beneficial.

The annual working time is 1612 hours based on the general collective agreement for Finnish universities and tasks are agreed in more detail in the Annual Work Plan.
