- For senior candidates, in addition to research and teaching excellence, a successful record in supervising and placing PhD students and a history of conducting research with junior faculty are highly desirable
- Candidates must be able to teach in English.
- The positions will be filled at the appropriate rank depending on the profile and experience of the candidate
