- Publishing in top peer-reviewed journals related to Tourism & Hospitality Management (ranked in FNEGE/ABS, SCOPUS-indexed);
- Participating in the research activities of the Institut Lyfe ;
- Conducting research and building synergies to strengthen interdisciplinary approaches in Hospitality/Gastronomy/Wine & Beverage ;
