TENURED PROFESSOR OF FINANCE

Job description

We seek a talented and highly motivated individual with a high-level academic expertise and track record in publishing leading finance journals. The objective of the professorship is to lead and carry out research and development processes in the field of finance including leading a research group.

We welcome candidates from any area of finance. In particular, research in financial risk management, asset pricing, sustainable finance, green assets and green bonds, ESG topics would be an asset. In alignment with the general aspirations of TalTech, the professor is expected to put some focus on digitalization and green transformation.

The position may be filled as tenure track or tenured associate professor or full professor, depending on the candidate's merits and career stage. The appointee will be required to conduct research in the field of finance as well as closely related fields, collaborate with other research teams both nationally and internationally, stimulate research activities at Tallinn University of Technology (TalTech), and apply for research grant funding from national and international sources. The professor is expected to lead the finance research in the department, including attracting and applying for funding from national and international sources and through that attract new PhD students and grow the research team. The suitable candidate would continuously work on the expansion of national and international networks involving both academics and practitioners. The candidate is also expected to teach and supervise (or co-supervise) at all levels and mentor early-stage researchers.

The position is full-time, with 1.0 workload, and the location of work is Tallinn, Estonia. The position will be filled in by agreement with the selected candidate on first opportunity.

Requirements

- PhD (or an equivalent) degree in the relevant field.
- Postdoctoral or other international work experience in areas related to finance research.



- Strong publication record that proves the ability for high quality and relevant research in finance and related fields.
- Proven ability to obtain funding from national as well as international sources.
- Experience in leading research groups and coordination of research activities.
- Experience in teaching and supervising at all levels (BSc, MSc and PhD level; executive trainings).
- Successful supervision of one or more doctoral theses.
- Active participation in relevant international networks.
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to work independently.
- Fluent written and oral communication skills in English.
